- **Problem Description & Architecture:**
- **Brief Solution - Step by Step:**

1. When we install some programs, we will find the specific port holding by other program.
2. Open terminal and use command “netstat -ano | findstr :80”, the red area is the target port.

```
netstat -nao | findstr :80
```

And we can get the result:

TCP	0.0.0.0:80	0.0.0.0:0	LISTENING	5932
-----	------------	-----------	-----------	------

3. 5932 is the program pid. And then we can use command “tasklist | findstr 5932” to find the program.

```
tasklist | findstr 5932
```

And we can get the result.

Skype.exe	5932 Console	1	184,628 K
-----------	--------------	---	-----------

Now we can find Skype holds this port.

4. Finally we can stop Skype to make the installation step goes on.
