1. Modify Repository File (</etc/yum.repos.d/>)

3. yum clean
4. yum update
5. yum install google-chrome-stable
6. yum install cups-libs-i686
7. execute google-chrome
8. Setup Proxy Server
 - You couldn't config proxy setting in browser. Please execute
"google-chrome --proxy-server=ip_address:port" to enable browser with proxy setting. For proxy server,
you could test with the list on website(<http://www.hidemyass.com/proxy-list/>)
